Bell 先生と英語部の Miho と Eita が、カナダにある姉妹校 (sister school) の生徒との文化交流 (cultural exchange) でどのような催しをするかについて話し合いをしています。次の英文は、話し合いと、話し合い後に書いた Eita の部活動記録です。(1)～(5)に答えなさい。

話し合い

Ms. Bell : Have you decided what you are going to do at the cultural exchange with the students from our sister school ?

Miho : We are thinking about serving *matcha* to them.

Ms. Bell : That's nice. Why did you choose that ?

Miho : We found an interesting article. According to it, *matcha* is becoming popular around the world. A lot of people drink *matcha* for their (あ) . For example, they don't get sick easily when they drink it every day. We got interested in *matcha* because we read this.

Ms. Bell : In my country, the United States, there are lots of cafes that serve *matcha*. It is used not only in drinks, but also in sweets like ice cream and cakes.

Miho : *Matcha* is so popular in your country, too.

Ms. Bell : Well, (い) ?

Eita : We're thinking about that. Tea ceremony is a good way to serve *matcha* to foreign students, but it is too difficult for us. There are many rules in tea ceremony, and we don't have time to practice for it. Do you have any ideas ?

Ms. Bell : Let me see. I often enjoy *matcha* in a glass with some fruit juice. My favorite is orange juice. The colors of orange and green are beautiful. In this way, I can enjoy both the taste and the colors of the tea.

Miho : That way is new to me. I would like to try it.

Eita : I see. However, I want to show the students a Japanese way.

Miho : Why don't we serve Japanese green tea prepared in a teapot ?

Eita : Will you put *matcha* in it ?

Miho : No. We will use tea leaves that are different from *matcha*.

Eita : OK. I understand.

Miho : I hear that Japanese green tea prepared in a teapot is also getting popular in Europe, Asia, and other foreign countries. I think that serving it to our guests is traditional Japanese culture.

Ms. Bell : Wow, that's a good idea. To prepare Japanese green tea in a teapot is one part of Japanese culture that foreign people want to experience. I think that (う) many of them want to know how to do it.

Eita : Sounds good. However, I don't know how to do it because I don't use a teapot at home. Instead, I often drink Japanese green tea from a plastic bottle.

Miho : In my family, my father likes preparing Japanese green tea in a teapot. We usually drink it with dinner. I can ask my father how to do that.



- Eita : That sounds great. Then, we can learn how to do that. It is good for us to know about our own culture.
- Miho : That's true. To show our own culture to people from other countries, we have to know a lot about it.

Today, I want to share my experience and what I learned from it.

When I was ten years old, I joined the local basketball team and started playing basketball. <sup>(あ)</sup>I was doing everything I could do to become a good player. On weekdays, I practiced hard early in the morning and after school. I often watched videos of basketball games. I slept for eight hours a day and didn't eat anything between meals.

When I entered high school, I became a member of the basketball team at school. One day, a basketball referee came to our high school to give a lecture to us. She was one of the best basketball referees in Japan. I asked her, "What do you enjoy the most as a basketball referee?" She answered, "I enjoy meeting people of different generations by refereeing. I also enjoy discovering new things that I've never known as a basketball player." <sup>(い)</sup>Her answer made me interested in basketball referees. I thought, "If I become a basketball referee, I will learn something that I haven't learned yet." I used the Internet and got some information about basketball referees. There are six kinds of qualification for them, and even people of my age can get one. With the qualification, I can become a basketball referee of official basketball games in my local community.

I decided to become a basketball referee. On the Internet, I had a test about the rules after some lectures. Then, I got a basketball referee qualification and started refereeing at official basketball games in my local community. At my first game as a basketball referee, I was in charge of the junior high school students' game. I was so (う) before the game. When other basketball referees saw me, they said, "Don't worry, Yuji. Everyone gets scared at first." After the game, they gave me a lot of advice to make the game more exciting. I thought, "If I had more knowledge and skills, I could ( <sup>(え)</sup>experience / more exciting / the players / help ) games."

I read many books about basketball rules and watched many basketball games. I often practiced refereeing at practice games. I became confident after a lot of experiences. One day, after a kids' game, the players came to me and said, "Thank you. You are a good referee." When I heard these words, I was (お) because I felt that I was needed as a basketball referee. My efforts were successful.

Through basketball, I enjoy meeting other basketball referees, coaches, and players of different ages in our local community. My experience has connected me with people, and I want to help them. I learned this: We can be useful to our local community with our knowledge and our skills. I didn't realize that as a player. We, high school students, have things we can do for (か).
